Point of Order	A delegate recognizes a procedural error. The Chair must rule on it immediately	NA	NA	Any time
Point of Personal Privilege	A delegate is experiencing personal discomfort that impairs his or her ability to participate	NA	NA	Any time
Right of Reply	A delegate has been personal attacked or impugned by a speech. He must request a right of reply in writing to the chair. There are no rights of reply to a right of reply	NA	NA	After a personal attack has been made on a delegate (Speaker's List)
Point of Inquiry	A delegate has a question regarding a matter of parliamentary procedure	NA	NA	Any time
Point of Information	A delegate has a question of a factual nature that he needs answered	NA	NA	Any time
Appeal of the Chair	A delegate disagrees with the Chair's decision can motion to appeal the decision. The Chair can chose to take back the decision or to speak in defense of the decision. If he defends the decision it goes to a vote	The Chair may defend his/her decision	Unanimous	Whenever the rules don't say it isn't allowed
Set the Speakers Time	Set the time allotted to each speaker while on the Primary or Secondary Speaker's List. The default time is one minute	no	Simple majority	While on any speaker's list
Adopt the Agenda	A delegate wishes to set the agenda. This is only in order while on the Primary Speakers list. Cannot be appealed	2 for 2 against	Simple Majority	While on the Primary Speaker's list
Adjourn	A Delegate wishes to end committee until the next session. Cannot be appealed	NA	Simple Majority	When the time is right
Suspension of the Meeting	Same as Adjourn	NA	Simple Majority	When the time is right
Censure	If a delegate believes another delegate is clearly and constantly misrepresenting his/her country's policy then they can request that the offending delegate be censured	Offending delegate is given 2 minutes for defense	Super majority	While on any speaker's list
Competence	A delegate feels that the body is not capable to handle the current topic. Cannot be raised during voting procedure	2 for 2 against	Super majority	While on the secondary speaker's list
Suspension of the Rules	A delegate wishes to have certain rules modified or discarded. Must explain the reason. Cannot be appealed	No	Super majority	While on any speaker's list
Moderated Caucus	A motion to have the chair (or other party) call on speaker's outside of the speaker's list. Must include total time and speaking time.	No	Simple Majority	While on any speaker's list
Unmoderated Caucus	A motion to suspend all rules for a designated time to accommodate delegate needs	No	Simple Majority	While on any speaker's list
Quorum Check	If a delegate believes that a quorum isn't present.	No	NA	While on any speaker's list
Close Debate	Ends debate and begins voting procedure	2 for 2 against	Super majority	While on the secondary speaker's list
Table the Topic	To temporarily end debate on a subject. Cannot be taken from the table during the same session it was tabled during.	2 for 2 against	Super majority	While on the secondary speaker's list
Reorder the Proposals	To change the order of the draft resolutions before voting begins	No	Simple Majority	Voting Procedure
Friendly Amendment	An amendment supported by all the Sponsors of a Draft Resolution.	No	Automatically incorporated	While on the secondary speaker's list
Unfriendly Amendment	An amendment not supported by all the Sponsors. Must have 3 Sponsors of its own and 1/3 of the voting members as sponsors/signatories	No	Incorporated after a vote in Voting Procedure	While on the secondary speaker's list
Divide the Question	Once debate has been closed and before any voting begins, a delegate can motion to divide the question, or to vote on specific single or groups of operative clauses separately	2 for 2 against	Simple Majority	Voting Procedure
Important Question	A motion to stress the importance of the draft resolution (must meet the qualifications in the rules). Requires 2/3 to pass the resolution. Cannot be appealed	2 for 2 against	Super majority	Voting Procedure
Introduce a Proposal	A delegate motions to introduce a proposal once it meets the requirements for a draft resolution. Must be given prior approval by the dais.	Dais Approval.	No vote, the Q/A period can be extended with Simple	While on the secondary speaker's list
Roll Call Vote	Vote of a resolution in alphabetical order	No	Simple Majority	Voting Procedure
Reconsideration	A delegate that voted in the winning side want to revote on the issue. Must be in the same session as the original vote	2 for 2 against	Super majority	Voting Procedure
Set the Default Yield	Change the default yield from yielding to the chair to something else	no	Simple majority	Any time
Comment	Motion to permit or remove comments on a speakers during formal debate	no	Simple majority	While on any speaker's list
